Creamware – Earthen ware invented in the last ½ of the 18th cent. People in England didn't like the cream colour for about 5 years. It was first sold under the name “Queens ware”

Transfer Printed ware- Pattern is put onto copper with metallic oxide paint. Two different designs. (perhaps one rim and one interior)

Flowing colours ware- Also know as flow blue. Deliberately blurred by putting pigment into glaze. Normally BLUE or PINK

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
