LIST OF THINGS TO BRING/WEAR ON
EXCAVATIONS DAYS

1. Rain gear – hat, coat, etc...
2. Work gloves – not required but strongly encouraged (can be bought from Mark’s Work warehouse for approximately \$5.00).
3. Suitable footwear like running shoes or boots – feet must be adequately covered – hiking or work boots acceptable but no winter boots and NO SANDALS!
4. ★ Sunscreen (SPF must be higher than 20)– campers will be in sun most of the day. Required all week.
5. Head Covering - baseball cap, bandana, etc...
6. Shorts and t-shirts can be worn if you have adequate sunscreen. Wear clothes you don’t mind getting dirty. Camp t-shirts will be distributed on the Monday of camp week, these should be worn on excavation days!
7. ★ Lunches, drinks and snacks for break times. There are no corner stores or shops close by to purchase a lunch so it must be brought from home. Required each day.
8. ★ All writing equipment – pens, pencils, erasers, etc. Put your name on them with tape so that they are not lost. Required each day.
9. Participants should have an up-to-date tetanus shot.
